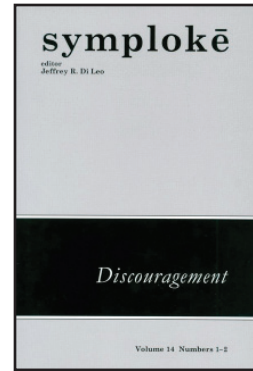

It is a forum for scholars from a variety of disciplines to exchange ideas in innovative ways. Most of the journal’s issues address topics of special interest that open new avenues of inquiry and research. Scholarship focusing on the interrelationship of philosophy, literature, cultural criticism, and intellectual history is of particular interest. *symplokē* received the Phoenix Award 2000 for Outstanding Editorial Achievement from the Council of Editors of Learned Journals.
